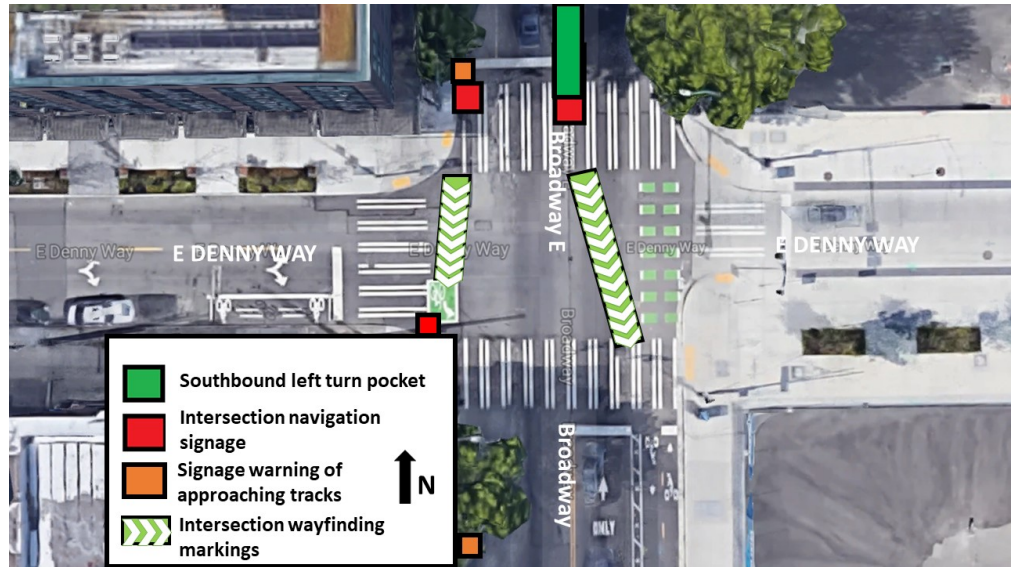


STREETCAR AND BICYCLE SAFETY ENHANCEMENTS

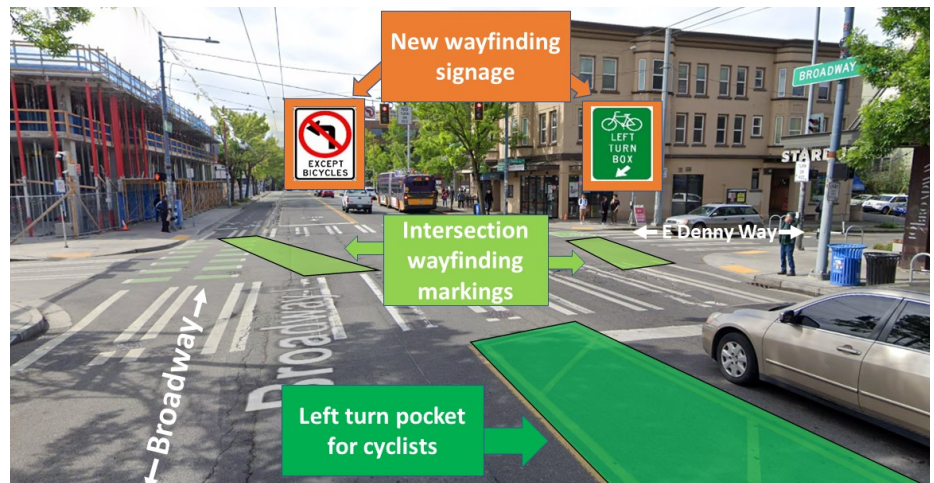
Broadway E and E Denny Way

The Seattle Department of Transportation is working to address safety concerns for people that bike at the intersection of Broadway E and E Denny Way.

Southbound cyclists often miss the entrance to the Broadway protected bike lane (PBL) which begins at the southeast corner of Broadway and Denny. Several enhancements will be made to provide maximum separation for people who bike from the streetcar tracks and to guide them to use the existing PBL:



- Add a left turn pocket for southbound cyclists at the intersection. Include signage permitting people who bike to turn left into the PBL and use the pedestrian 'all-walk' signal;
- Add signage alerting of approaching streetcar tracks;
- Maintain the two-stage left turn at the southwest corner of the intersection as a left turn option for southbound cyclists who miss the new left turn pocket. Add signage on the west side of Broadway directing people who bike to use the two-stage turn to enter the PBL;
- Add intersection wayfinding markings to clearly delineate desired bike paths.



The enhancements are planned for the end of 2019.
